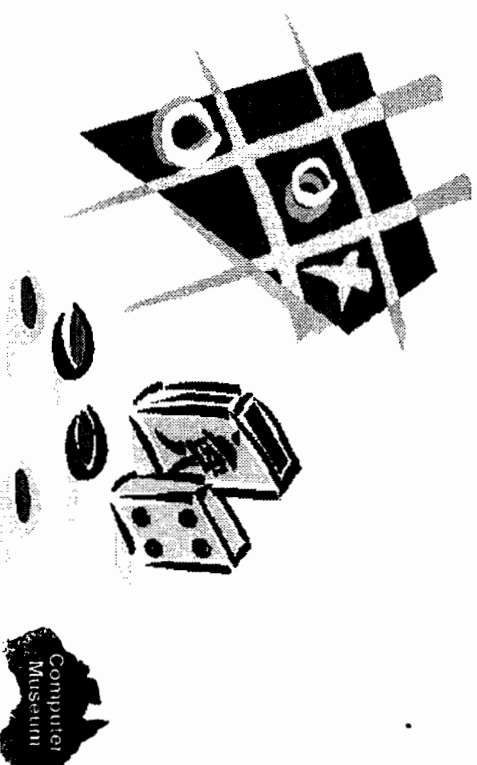
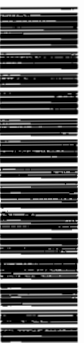


INSTALLING THE STRATEGY GAMES ON YOUR HP OMNIGO 100

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Introduction

The Strategy Games disk contains 6 separate games for the HP OmniGo 100.

Included with the games is the OmniGo 100 Installer program. Installer enables you to install as many or as few games as you like. You can also use Installer to uninstall individual games whenever you want.

Installer gives you the option to install to 3 different places:

- To the OmniGo 100 main memory (requires OmniGo 100 Serial Cable).
- To a PCMCIA SRAM card in your OmniGo 100 (requires OmniGo 100 Serial Cable).
- To a PCMCIA SRAM card in the PCMCIA drive on your PC (requires a PC with a built-in PCMCIA card drive and a PCMCIA SRAM card).

Requirements

PC or compatible running Microsoft Windows (version 3.1 or later) or Windows95.

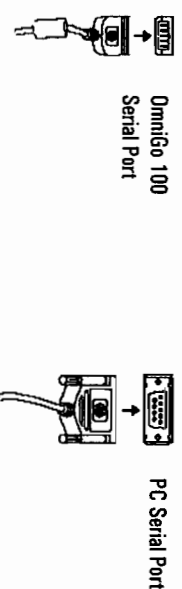
For Windows 3.1, minimum recommended configuration is a 386/33 PC with 4 MB RAM.



For Windows95, minimum recommended configuration is a 486/33 PC with 8 MB RAM.

For installation methods requiring an OmniGo Serial Cable, the cable is HP part number F1015A. To use the serial cable, you must have a serial port available on your PC.

Installing to main memory or a PCMCIA SRAM card in your OmniGo 100

1. Insert the Strategy Games diskette into your PC's A: or B: drive.
2. Attach one end of the OmniGo 100 Serial Cable to your OmniGo 100, and the other end to your PC serial port.



3. To install the games to a PCMCIA SRAM card, insert the card into your OmniGo 100.
4. On the OmniGo 100, tap , then tap .
5. In the OmniGo 100 Transfer application, tap PC and then choose Connect.
6. In Windows Program Manager, click the File menu. If you are using Windows95, click the Start button.
7. Click Run.
8. Enter A:INSTALL or B:INSTALL.
9. Follow the instructions that appear on the screen. After you finish installing, the games will appear on the OmniGo 100 Home Screen.

Installing to a PCMCIA SRAM card in a PCMCIA drive on your PC

1. Insert the Strategy Games diskette into your PC's A: or B: drive.
2. Insert an OmniGo 100-compatible PCMCIA SRAM card into your PC's PCMCIA card drive.
3. In Windows Program Manager, open the File menu. If you are using Windows95, click the Start button.
4. Click Run, and enter A:INSTALL or B:INSTALL.
5. Follow the instructions on the PC screen.

6. After you complete installation, remove the PCMCIA SRAM card from the PC and insert it in your OmniGo 100. The games automatically appear on the Home Screen when you turn on your OmniGo 100. If the games do not appear on the Home Screen, try removing the card, turning the OmniGo 100 on and off, then re-inserting the card.

Removing a game

You can uninstall games with the Installer program as follows:

1. Insert the Strategy Games diskette into your A: or B: drive.
2. If you are uninstalling a game from the OmniGo 100 main memory, or from a PCMCIA SRAM card in the OmniGo 100, then follow the instructions above for Installing to the OmniGo 100 main memory or a PCMCIA SRAM card.
3. If you are uninstalling a game from a PCMCIA SRAM card in a PCMCIA drive on your PC, then follow the instructions above for Installing to a PCMCIA SRAM card in a PCMCIA drive on your PC.
4. When you reach the main screen of the Installer program, a list of installed games will appear in the Destination area of the screen.
5. Click the title of the game you want to uninstall in the destination list, then click the Uninstall button. This will remove the selected game from the OmniGo 100 or memory card.

Preparing to remove a game

Before you commence uninstalling a game on your OmniGo 100, launch that game and press **[FN] [E3]**. Refer to the section *Removing a game* for the remaining procedure to continue uninstalling the game.

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
